




1 - New Sidebar




With the aim of providing greater clarity and usability, we introduced on uSee a **new sidebar with dual view mode**. The sidebar can be opened or closed using the hamburger menu/close buttons:  


While the sidebar is closed, all environments and configuration in the sidebar are still accessible.

1 - New Sidebar






2 - Site List

Servers are organized **as per sites**, and sites are organized in **alphabetical order**.

The site list also indicates **how many servers a site has**, and **how many servers are online**.

Site list shows servers with **active cameras** in your layout.




3 - Events

We designed a **new notification button** in the top bar.




In addition, you can also access the Live events panel **directly from the sidebar**.



4 - Thumbnail Search


Thumbnail Search is separated from the event panel and now has **its own environment**.

Step 1: Open Thumbnail Search in sidebar


Step 2: Select your time frame for the search




4 - Thumbnail Search

5 - Improved Page Navigation


Ever wondered what environment you are currently in?

We added **page navigation indicators** to the top bar.

The current environment can be seen next to the uSee logo:




When the sidebar is closed you will only see the environment's icon:

The user button allows you to **logout**, as well as view your **account settings**.




6 - Display Layouts


Currently on Omnia Web you see all your active layouts in a tab layout in the top bar.

uSee offers you the **ability to choose** how you would like to display the layouts, either in a **tab layout** as previously, or you can see them in a **dropdown**.






To select which way you want to see the layouts, you must switch it on in the user settings, under the “layout settings” tab.




7 - Layouts
