What is u-Follow?

u-Follow is uSee's newest feature, allowing operators to easily follow people and objects of interest across different devices.

- No need to learn where the devices are placed to follow a person or object
- Easy to set up and use
- No need to change or add hardware



Where u-Follow?






HOW u-Follow?

 Finding u-Follow configuration

To access the u-Follow configuration page you first have to find it in the Sidebar





Before being able to create a sequence, you first have to choose the site

**Sequences are saved per site



Once you have selected a site then you can create a new sequence





🌀 Creating and setting up of a sequence

Once a sequence has been created, you can then add cameras to the sequence.

Green border = place a camera there



Once your first camera is placed, you will see white flashing borders – this indicates where you can place your next device.



Click this icon  if you want to locate the camera in the devicelist



🌀 Editing a sequence

If you want to change a device in the sequence, you can click on the device's thumbnail, then modify.

Then you can select a new device.



Closing a sequence

You can “close” a sequence, this feature is great if you want a sequence on your perimeter.



To close a sequence, press this button


This will take the uttermost left, or right device, to complete the sequence.

Closing a sequence

To break the connection, which will allow you to add more devices, you can click the “Break connection” button



Deleting a sequence

If a sequence was created, but is not needed anymore, you are able to delete the sequence by pressing the “Delete sequence” button



 Access a sequence

If a camera is part of a sequence, you will see this icon  in the video player

u-Follow is only available in WebRTC format.



HOW u-Follow?

Live view

🌀 Access a sequence

Clicking the u-Follow button in a video player will initiate the sequence in a new tab.



**Notes:

- 🌀 If you have NOT opened a sequence previously, then uSee will open a new tab and populate the video in that tab
- 🌀 If you have the u-Follow tab open, then the video will populate in that tab


HOW u-Follow?

Live view

 Access a sequence

If you close the sequence in the new tab, you will be presented with a uSee view where you're not able to choose any other environments.

You can select a new sequence from the live dashboard and it will be populated in this tab



HOW u-Follow?

Live view

- 🌀 Moving through devices in a sequence

Clicking on the arrows will allow you to see the adjacent camera(s).



HOW u-Follow?

Live view

 Access a sequence

If the device is part of more than one sequence, then a pop up will appear prompting the user to choose a sequence.





Limitations

- Once a device has been added to a sequence, that device can't be deleted, only swapped out
- Fisheye cameras do not work with u-Follow
- u-Follow is only available on uSee and with WebRTC enabled cameras
- Sequences should have unique names and be less than 25 chars
