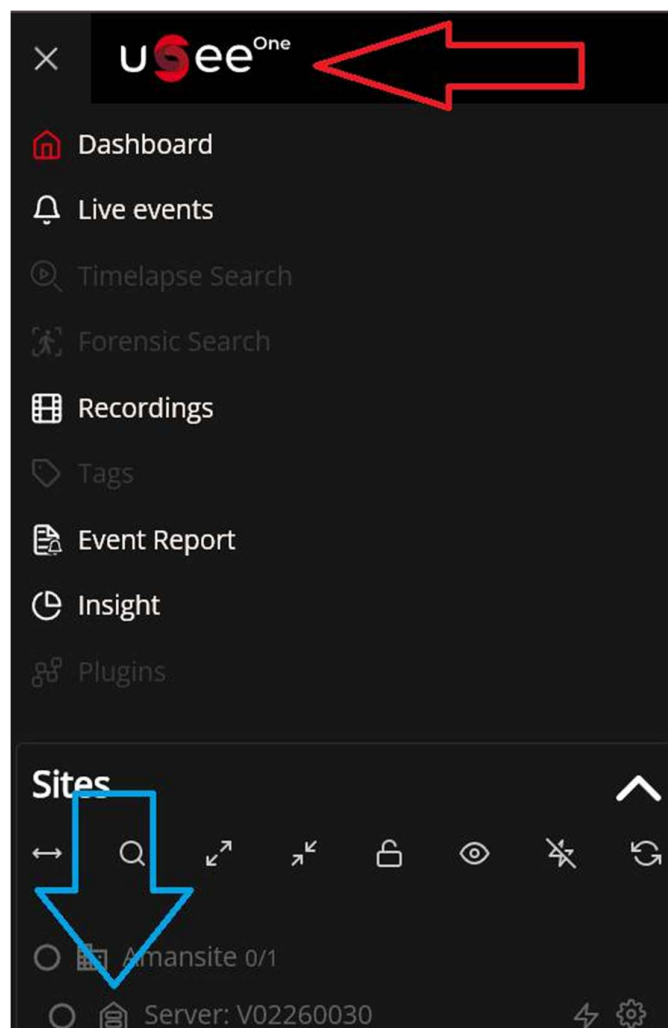


uSee One:

The name and logo of the uSee Lite version, previously known as *Omnia Web*, have been updated.

From now on, if a user has only one On-Premise product on their sites, uSee will automatically switch to uSee One.

Below is an example of uSee running in the uSee One version due to the presence of an on-premise server (blue arrow).



Feature:

Static Maps – Device Icon and Label Display Improvements

Introduced new controls to better manage the visibility and readability of devices on the map.

Users can now resize device icons and labels using the new zoom in and zoom out buttons. This allows users to adjust the display size of cameras and related labels, making it easier to view all devices on the map.

A new show/hide device names button has also been added, allowing users to hide camera names when they need a cleaner map view, or show them again when device identification is required.

The selected icon size and device name visibility preferences are persisted for each user on the current device.
